

The Sachsenring (Germany) hosted the sixth round of the 2024 FIM Enel MotoE World Championship season

The sixth round of the **2024 FIM Enel MotoE World Championship** was staged at the Sachsenring circuit in Germany. It was a “back to back” for the **Aruba Cloud MotoE team** in action for the second consecutive weekend after the Dutch round.

RACE-1

In the race reduced to 5 laps due to the red flag shown after Granado's crash, **Chaz Davies** got off a good start moving up from P15 to P12. The Welsh rider's race pace did not allow him to be incisive finishing in P14.

Armando Pontone's race ended at the first corner when he was forced to brake hard after Granado's crash, however, failing to avoid contact with Manfredi.

RACE-2

Race 2 was delayed by almost two hours late - with a length of 8 laps - due to a violent storm that hit the circuit when the riders were already on the grid.

Armando Pontone was the protagonist of a positive performance. From mid-race, the Italian driver pushed with confidence and managed to overtake Zannoni, Finello and Manfredi to finish in 12th position.

Sixteenth place instead for **Chaz Davies**, who didn't manage to find a good pace in wet conditions.

Armando Pontone (Aruba Cloud MotoE #80) Race-1 DNF | Race-2 P12

"It was a comeback race in a condition we had never experienced before. I am happy with this result because when I gained confidence I could push and recover positions. I can say it's a good reaction after this morning's mistake."

Chaz Davies (Aruba Cloud MotoE #7) Race-1 P14 | Race-2 P16

"Compared to Assen, in Race-1 we couldn't recreate the same feeling. We worked with the team on the chassis then obviously the intense rain mixed all the cards and I didn't find the conditions to be able to push."

The FIM Enel MotoE World Championship calendar includes two more rounds: the first in Austria on August 16-17, the second for the Grand Finale in Misano at World Circuit Marco Simoncelli on September 6-7.
