



Chaz Davies and Armando Pontone finish 12th in Race-1 and Race-2, respectively

An extraordinary crowd presence was the setting for the second round of the Fim Enel MotoE World Championship staged in Le Mans, France.

Race-1

Despite a difficult qualifying, Armando Pontone is the protagonist of a solid comeback in Race-1 ended in 12th place after a good battle with Tulovic.

Chaz Davies, on the other hand, had to deal with a problem at the start that did not allow him to stay with the group. The Welsh rider, however, had the merit of staying focused and pushing with conviction to take 13th position with an overtaking move on Herrera on the last lap.

P12 Armando Pontone (Aruba Cloud MotoE #90)

"We had a good race because we rode on this circuit for the first time. After a first lap that was not easy, I gained confidence and managed to keep a good race pace."

P13 Chaz Davies (Aruba Cloud MotoE #7)

"Unfortunately, the problem at the start did not allow me to have references but I still have to say that the feeling with the bike improved lap by lap."

Race-2

Chaz Davies recovers six positions and closes in 12th place while Armando Pontone, after a non-incisive start, crashes on lap 5.

P12 Chaz Davies (Aruba Cloud MotoE #7)

"It's clear that the grid position didn't allow us to be able to stay with the Top 10 group but the feeling with the bike still grew during the weekend and this is a good sign ahead of the next rounds."

DNF Armando Pontone (Aruba Cloud MotoE #90)

"Unfortunately, a crash compromised the race. However, the feeling remains that we are on the right path and with the team we will try to have a good weekend in Barcelona."
