

Alessandro Zaccone aboard the Ducati V21L of the Aruba Cloud Team in the 2025 FIM MotoE World Championship season

The Aruba Cloud MotoE Team is pleased to announce Alessandro Zaccone as a new rider for 2025 FIM MotoE World Championship Season.

The Italian rider, born in Rimini on 16 January 1999, joined the MotoE World Championship in 2020. Only a crash in the last round at Misano prevented him from becoming World Champion with the Pramac Racing MotoE team in 2021.

After the following season in Moto2, Zaccone returned to MotoE in 2023 with the Tech3 team, where he raced until the end of the 2024 championship.

For Zaccone, 44 total races in MotoE with 2 wins, 8 podiums and 6 pole positions achieved.
